Letter of Intent for cooperation in the fields of education, science and research

I.

By signing this Letter of Intent the parties are willing to cooperate in the field of education, research and science.

II.

The purpose of this Letter of Intent is to enhance the existing friendly relations between the parties in academic cooperation in the field of:

- a) Students' (including doctoral students) mobilities and exchanges,
- b) Teachers' mobilities and exchanges,
- c) Staff mobilities and exchanges,
- d) Joint scientific research,
- e) Joint participation in international programs,
- f) Development and implementation of potential double degree programs,
- g) Joint education in common areas,
- h) Combined participation and support in exercises and wargaming activities,
- i) Exchange of lessons learned.

III.

In the field of science, the parties are willing to cooperate in mutual projects, in organization and co-organization of conferences. The parties are also willing to

participate in publishing in professional journals including the participation in editorial councils and publishing.

The conditions for closer cooperation in individual cases or projects in accordance with this Letter of Intent, will be stipulated in separate agreements between the parties.

IV.

The principles of the cooperation between the parties are based on the fact that each party as a delegating institution covers the costs concerning the delegation of its students, teachers and researchers in compliance with the internal regulation of the delegating institution in the area in question.

V.

The receiving institution is expected to enable the delegated persons to participate in educational process or research and will provide free access to the library services, archives, laboratories and to the net services accordingly.

This cooperation is governed by the principle of reciprocity.

VI.

This Letter of Intent is valid from 01 February 2024 until 01 January 2029, after this date it will expire without further notice.

Should either party wish to leave the cooperation under this Letter of Intent before the end date above, the other party should be given a written notice four months in advance. The four months" notice period commences by the first day of the following month after the delivery of the written notice. The other party is to confirm the receipt of notice.

The termination of this Letter of Intent will not affect any ongoing projects or internships under this Letter of Intent.

VII.

The separate agreements mentioned under III above should aim to regulate the relations between the parties and not between individuals and an institution.

VIII.

The relations stated in this Letter of Intent are in accordance with the legal order of Ukraine and of Sweden.

This Letter of Intent is not intended to create any legal obligations for any of the parties.

This Letter of Intent shall be governed under the laws of Sweden.

Any dispute ensuing from the interpretation or implementation of this Letter of Intent shall be settled through direct negotiations between the parties. If the negotiations do not lead to a settlement within reasonable time, the dispute will finally be settled by a competent court in Stockholm according to the laws of Sweden.

This Letter of Intent is made in English and Ukrainian languages, in two equally authentic counterparts. Each party shall receive one signed counterpart in the above-mentioned languages. In the event of any discrepancy between the two versions or when interpreting the Letter of Intent, the English version will take precedence.
